What we are learning about:

Numeracy



In Number, Primary 1 will be learning to count, read, order, write and recognise numbers 0-20. We are going to create shape and colour patterns. We will be learning the days of the week and months of the year. Primary 2 will be learning to count in 2s and 10s and identify the missing number in a sequence. P1 & P2 will also be using the language of measurement through lengths, weight and capacity and making comparisons.

Literacy

In Literacy, Primary 1 will be learning about sounds; recognising a sound by looking at a letter and identifying words that start with that particular sound. We will also be learning to blend these sounds together to make words. Primary 2 will be learning two letter 'magic' sounds and finding them within words. We will also be using these sounds to help up spell words accurately. In Listening and Talking, P2/1 will be working on being a good Audience.

Health and Wellbeing

In PE we are working on our team work skills, ensuring that we understand what makes a good team mate and how to effectively communicate with others. We will also be looking at what makes a good friend and the importance of kindness, gentleness, caring and sharing.

Things to remember...

PE: Our PE days are Monday and Friday. Please ensure that your child has a full Gym kit and no jewellery otherwise they will not be able to take part.

Home Learning: Your child should bring their Home Learning folder to school with them every Friday. Home Learning is a mix of activities and reading from the Home Learning folder and activities on Seesaw. This is to ensure a variety of tasks to make Home Learning enjoyable for your child.
