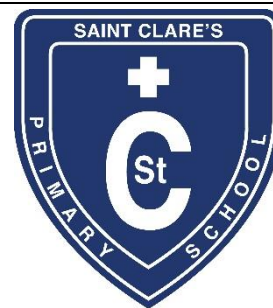




Miss Linden Primary 7/6 Term 1 Newsletter



What we are learning about:

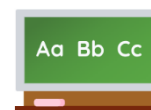
Numeracy



Our focus for numeracy this term will be rounding, place value, estimation & the 4 operations. We will be working through a range of multiplication and division strategies using CPA approaches (Concrete, Pictorial & Abstract resources) as well as number recognition beyond 100,000. Learners will learn various Glasgow Counts strategies to support and challenge their learning.

Our focus for maths this term will be revising 2D and 3D shape ensuring that learners can confidently discuss their properties. We will also focus on data handling and using appropriate vocabulary to discuss probability.

Literacy



Writing: Our focus for T1 is describing characters and improving our writing with exciting VCOP. Daily handwriting practice will incorporate the spelling words for the week. Grammar, VCOP and cursive will be completed daily through the school's Tools for Writing focus.

Reading: This term we will be further developing our reading strategies before, during and after reading. This term's focus will be predicting and decoding unfamiliar words.

Listening & Talking: The core skills will be taught from good listening, tone of voice and engagement of talking skills.

Health and Wellbeing

During our P.E time we have been focussing on team building activities and ball skills. As part of our topic this term we will be learning all about SHANARRI (*Safe, Healthy, Achieving, Nurtured, Active, Respected, Responsible and Included*). This term, learners will start an emotional bank account in which they can deposit and withdraw supportive and encouraging compliments to each other throughout the week.



STEM

Our Science topic this term is the Solar System and Energy. We will be taking part in various experiments and studies to use our prediction and hypothesis skills to conduct and conclude a fair experiment.
