


Miss McNulty Primary 2/1 **Term 3 Newsletter**



What we are learning about:

Numeracy



Primary 1 will develop their knowledge of:

- Addition and subtraction by counting on when adding to a group and on or back to find the difference.
- Data Handling by contributing to displays to represent data value and interpreting simple graphs.
- Time by reading analogue and digital clocks with o'clock and half past times.

Primary 2 will develop their knowledge of:

- Rounding 2-digit numbers to the nearest 10.
- Data handling by gathering data and presenting information appropriately.
- Time by using analogue and digital clocks to read and display o'clock and half past times.

Pupils will have regular opportunities to continue developing their counting skills, and reading and writing numbers from 0-20 and beyond.

Primary 1 will focus on:

Reading

- We will continue to develop our knowledge of sounds in the alphabet by reading, naming and blending them together to read simple words.
- We will continue to develop our sight word knowledge.

Writing

Children will use their learning about sounds to form letters with accuracy and 'have a go' at writing descriptive sentences independently,

Primary 2 will focus on:

Reading

- We will develop our understanding of using before, during and after reading strategies to help us understand a text.
- We will also continue to develop our knowledge of sounds and sight words.

Writing

We will learn about the features of persuasive and narrative writing and produce examples of these independently.

P1&2 Talking and Listening

Children will develop their skills in Group Talk.

Health and Wellbeing

In PE we are currently working on team games and fitness. In class we will be looking at the themes of sharing, caring and friendships and making good choices.

Religious Education

We will continue exploring the Bible stories as well as celebrating religious events in the liturgical calendar. We will continue to practise our Mass responses.

Things to remember...
