

## What we are learning about:

### Numeracy



In numeracy this term we are learning to round two-digit numbers to the nearest 10. We have also explored how to share equally. Additionally, we will be learning to recognise the tens and ones within numbers and will be working on recognising the place value of numerals within two-digit numbers.

Primary 2 will also be learning to tell the time using o'clock and half past on both the digital and analogue clock. Please reinforce this at home.

### Literacy

Primary 2 have learned about the key features of narrative writing and will be exploring poetry, producing these independently. We will continue to work on sentence structure to ensure that children are growing in confidence when structuring their own sentences. Within reading, we will be developing our knowledge of common words as well as working on reading with fluency and expression. The children will be working on finding and using information from non-fiction texts.

For listening and talking, we will be developing our skills in Group Talk.

### Health and Wellbeing

In PE we are currently working on developing our skills in games including badminton and developing our teamwork skills.

In class we will be looking at feelings and emotions and how this drives our behaviour. As well as exploring ways we can have a healthy lifestyles.

### Religious Education

Within RE this term we will focus on Lent and why this is a special time for our Faith. We will explore the Sacraments and their importance as well as continuing to practice our mass responses.
