### What we are learning about:


### Numeracy and Maths

In Numeracy this term we will build upon our knowledge of fractions and decimal numbers to include calculating percentages. Learners will explore number sequences including negative and decimal numbers while further solidifying their place value knowledge of tenths, hundredths and thousandths.

In Maths we will build on our knowledge of angles through looking at ways in which we measure and compare angles. We will continue to look at different ways in which we gather, interpret and present data and begin to explore the relationship between speed, distance and time.

### Literacy

<u>Reading</u> This term, we will be finishing Coraline as our class novel and will be completing a variety of reading tasks



<u>Writing</u> Our extended writing pieces this term will focus on discursive (offering a balanced argument for and against) and explanation (information focused) writing styles. Daily Tools For Writing sessions will continue to develop cursive handwriting, grammar, VCOP and assist with our weekly spelling words.

<u>Listening & Talking</u> Learners will further develop their debating skills, undertaking specific roles within a group and focus on working collaboratively.
