What we are learning about:	
Numeracy	Literacy
 Primary 1 will develop their knowledge of: Numbers by identifying the missing number in a sequence. Multiplication and division by skip counting in 5s and doubling numbers. Fractions by identifying half and a quarter of a quantity. Primary 2 will develop their knowledge of: 	 Primary 1 will focus on: Reading We will continue to develop our knowledge of sounds in the alphabet by reading, naming and blending them together to read simple words. We will continue to develop our sight word knowledge. This term we will also focus on developing our comprehension skills by learning to locate an answer from a text
 Multiplying and dividing by 2 and 4. Transformation by plotting 2 figure grid references. Solving missing number problems and simple equations. Pupils will continue to have regular opportunities to continue developing their counting skills, and reading and writing numbers from 0-20 and beyond.
