What we are learning about:

Numeracy



In Numeracy this term, we will be learning to round twodigit numbers to the nearest 10. We will also be exploring how to share equally. Additionally, we will be learning to recognise the tens and ones within numbers and will be working on recognising the place value of numerals within two-digit numbers.

Primary 2 will also be learning to tell the times o'clock and half past on both the digital and analogue clocks. If you could reinforce this at home that would be greatly appreciated.

The children will also be developing their understanding of measurement by measuring length, weight, volume and mass using non-standard units.

Literacy

Primary 2 will be learning about the key features of persuasive and narrative writing and will produce these independently. We will continue to work on sentence structure daily to ensure that children are growing in confidence when structuring their own sentences. Within reading, we will be developing our knowledge of common words as well as working on reading with fluency and expression. The children will also be working on finding and using information from non-fiction texts. For Listening and Talking, we will be developing our skills in Group Talk.

Health and Wellbeing

In PE we are currently working on team games and our team work skills.

In class we will be looking at different feelings and expressing advanced emotions through various activities as well as exploring healthy lifestyles.

Religious Education

Within RE this term we will focus on Lent and why this is a special time for our faith. We will also explore the Sacraments and their importance as well as continuing to practise our Mass responses.

Things to remember...
